The proposed treaty and proposed protocol were both signed on August 29, 1989, and amplified by diplomatic notes signed the same day and on November 3, 1989. The proposed treaty would replace the existing income tax treaty between the two countries that was signed in 1954 and amended by a protocol signed in 1965. The Senate Committee on Foreign Relations has scheduled a public hearing on the proposed treaty on June 14, 1990. The proposed treaty is similar to other recent U.S. income tax treaties, the 1981 proposed U.S. model income tax treaty ( U.S. model treaty ), and the 1977 model income tax...
