From literary magazines, chapbooks, graphic novels, and countless articles, they and the students at 826 Michigan in Ann Arbor have assembled an essential if not required collection of 27 pieces by such contributors as Lesley Nneka Arimah, Daniel Alarcón, Box Brown, Rebecca Curtis, Victor Lodato, Claudia Rankine, Paul Salopek, Paul Tough, and Wells Tower.
