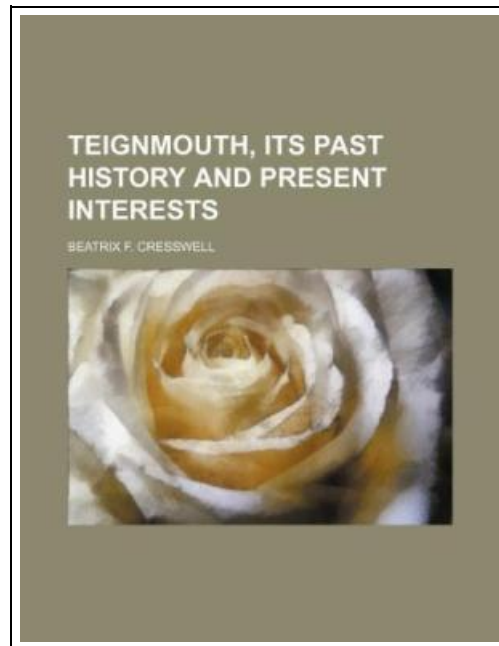

The large arch at the Shaldon side of the river should be avoided by those unfamiliar with the Teign, as the force of the current there frequently renders it very dangerous. In crossing the harbour mouth, there is at half-tide a considerable eddy from the Point, which must be remembered and calculated for. With these few warnings kept in mind, boating in the Teign need be attended by no risks. There may be a tug against tide, or it is possible to get aground on a sandbank, but no treacherous rock lies below water ready to tear out the bottom of a boat, and there are many hours when the oars may be shipped and the boat allowed to drift on the gentle current without fear of any harm. Until 1853 the port of Teignmouth was reckoned in nautical parlance as a creek under Exeter, but that year it was made a free port, with great festivities to commemorate the circumstance. Unfortunately the bar outside prevents any vessels of large tonnage coming into the harbour, though of late years some good-sized steamers, English, Danish, and Swedish, have entered to unload directly into railway trucks, that are brought close to the side of the quays. The length and convenience of the quays has also been much improved, but the New Quay, as it is called, is of interest from having been built in 1820,...
